SYSADMINS IN MANUFACTURING & CONSTRUCTION

SALARY

- **42%** earn less than the average for sysadmins (\$75K to \$100K a year)
- **58%** earn over \$75,000 a year

WORKLOAD

- **50%** manage 100–500 machines
- **34%** work solo (more than average)
- **56%** work in a team of 2 to 5 staff

FLEET

- **74%** said less than a quarter of their workforce was remote
- **26%** reported that their workforce was more than a quarter remote (less than average)
- **47%** manage PCs and Apple devices
- **53%** manage PCs only

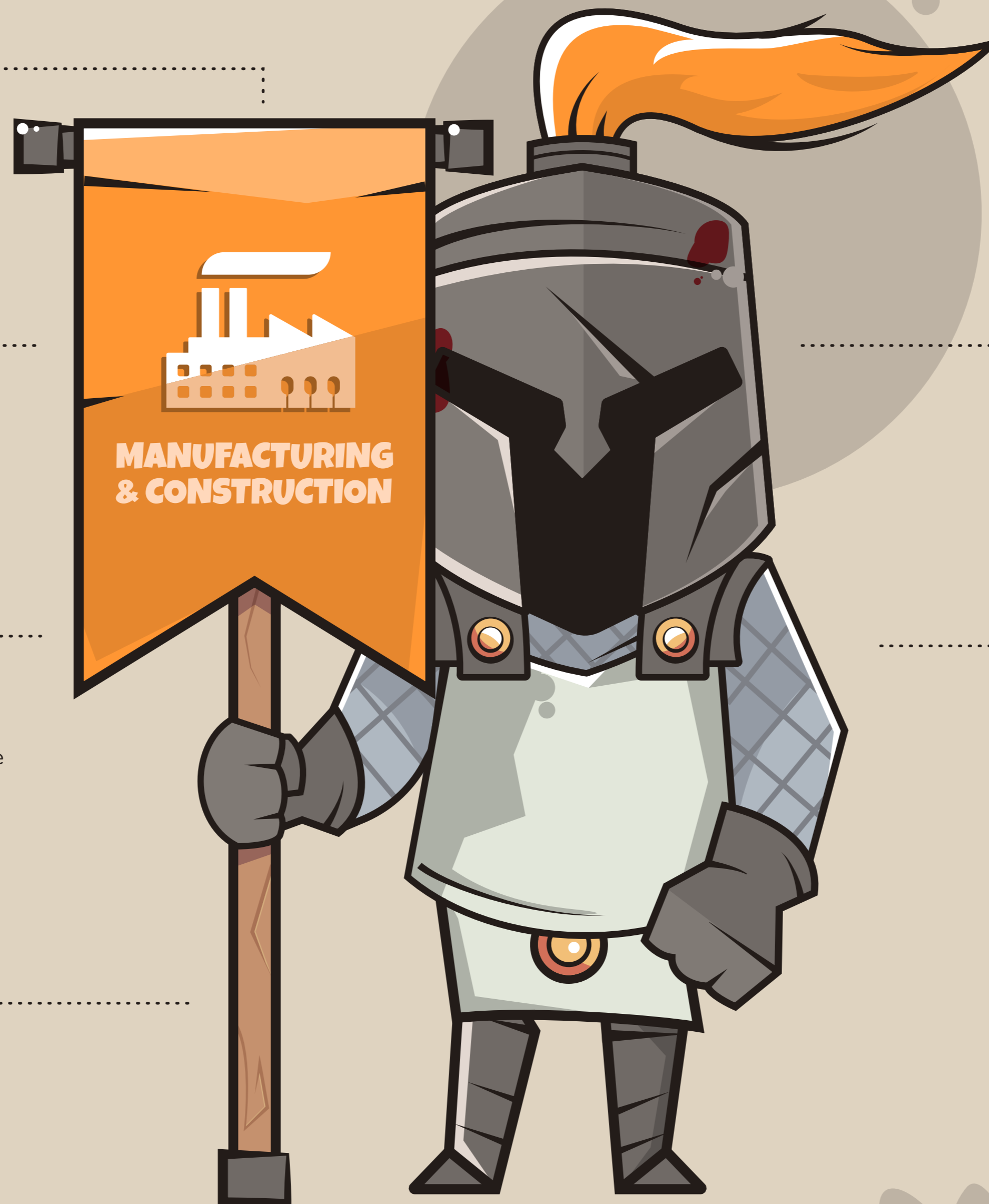
